

Recipient organizations are selected based on their ability to improve lives, individually and at a community level. Using Action Learning, WIAL creates true partnerships, where leadership are involved in a learning process they can replicate, and recipient organizations identify their own solutions.

1) Share our **Better World Fund: Camp Sizanani** Fundraising Appeal

Our recipient organization for the WIAL Better World Fund in 2015 is Global Camps Africa. which changes the lives of South Africa's vulnerable children and youth by providing HIV/AIDS prevention education and training through high-impact camp experiences and continuing education. At Camp Sizanani and follow-up Youth Clubs, vulnerable young people learn about protecting themselves from HIV, and gain confidence in their



ability to make choices to help them survive and thrive in the face of the world's most rampant AIDS epidemic.

Over the past decade, Global Camps Africa has changed the lives of more than 7,000 HIV-affected children in South Africa. A new, permanent facility – on land already owned by Global Camps Africa – would allow the organization to double the number of children served by their camps as well as train other organizations in Africa on how to use their curriculum models to improve children's lives. A grant of \$20,000 from the WIAL Better World Fund: Camp Sizanani would provide the support required by certified Action Learning coaches to support the



Global Camp Africa leaders and make this dream a reality.

3) Nominate a 2016 Recipient Organization
